### Top tips:

- Always properly read the question - If a question is asked in English, answer in English. If it is asked in German, answer in German.
- For the written question only answer what is being asked. Make sure to answer every question asked in the letter or e-mail. Only add extra sentences if they add to the question asked.
- If the question says to 'tick' the box, make sure to tick the box.
- A strong knowledge of vocabulary will be crucial for all parts of the exam.
- Use simple and correct grammar structures/sentences for the written part.
- Revise a small amount every day. Focus on one area a day and revise the vocabulary lists for each topics.
- Use the Pomodoro technique – 25 minute study timer and then take a break - repeat
