General Exams Tips

- Use PEA / PETAL
- Remember the marking scheme PCLM
- Answering the question directly is the number 1 priority
- TAPS for functional writing
- Read the question more than once and highlight key words in the question
- Read over your work AND the question
- Be careful of your time - better to attempt 5 questions than answer 3 well
- Capital letters & Punctuation!!

Comprehension

- Be prepared to answer on visual texts
